

Dear user, Anteprima Srl owns the brand Eppela, a crowdfunding platform, hereinafter "the company".

In its management of the Eppela platform, the company collects, processes and communicates the personal data of its users to third-parties, hereinafter also "the interested parties," who register to the site www.eppela.com to whatever ends.

The platform has offices in Italy and is thus subject to Italian state law. The company Anteprima Srl acts in full respect of Legislative Decree 196/2003 and, in compliance with that prescribed by article 13 of the mentioned decree, provides all indications on the processing of your personal data and your rights in this informative text, according to the "Data protection code." Before giving your consent to data processing, please read this information carefully.

1. COOKIES

Cookies are information, often containing a unique anonymous identification code, which is sent to the browser by a web server and is then recorded on the user's computer's hard disc. Cookies are then reread and recognised by the website which sent them if the site is visited again. They are required mainly for making the websites work or making them work better and for providing the site owner with commercial and marketing information.

By using the website, the visitor expressly authorises the use of cookies. The cookies used on our website are based on the categories established by the International Chamber of Commerce and, specifically, they are:

Strictly-necessary cookies: these are essential to allow you to browse our website and use the various functions. Without these, you cannot use search, comparing and purchasing services, or any of the other services available on the website.

These cookies do not collect information on you which could be used for marketing purposes nor do they track your web browsing. The installation of these cookies is a necessary condition for using the website. If you block them, the website does not work. You do not need to provide your consent for these cookies, since they are indispensable for providing the requested services.

Session cookies: these are essential for distinguishing the connected users, and are useful for preventing a requested function from being supplied to the wrong user, as well as for security purposes to prevent cyber attacks on the site. Session cookies do not contain personal data and last only for the session underway, that is, until the browser is closed. Consent is not required for

these. Performance cookies: these collect information on the use of the website, the pages which are visited and any errors which may occur while browsing. We use these cookies to recognise the website of origin of your visit to our website. These cookies do not collect information which can identify you. All information is collected anonymously and is used to help us improve the functioning of the website. Our cookies do not contain personal data. In some cases, some of these cookies are managed for us by third parties that are not, however, allowed to use them for purposes other than those previously listed. Using our site means accepting to use this type of cookie. If they are blocked, we are unable to guarantee the correct functioning of the site.

Functionality cookies: these are used to facilitate website browsing, to record the settings you have chosen and provide you with personalised functions. Selecting personalised settings and options means accepting the use of these cookies. In some cases, we may authorise advertisers or third parties to insert cookies on our website to offer you personalised contents and services. In any case, using our site means accepting to use this type of cookie. If they are blocked, we are unable to guarantee the correct functioning of the site.

Targeting cookies: these are used to collect information which is useful for showing you adverts which are related to your specific interests. These cookies allow you to share your website and click on "like" on social network sites like Facebook.

Our cookies may have a variable duration. Specifically, the session cookies are: valid for only one search or browsing session, i.e. they vanish when the browser is closed. Permanent cookies have a variable duration. The maximum duration of some cookies in this second category is 5 years. Due to the particular structure of our website, disabling cookies means you will not be able to browse the site and make use of our services. There are, however, a number of ways of managing cookies. By modifying the browser setting, you can disable the cookies or decide to receive a warning message before accepting one.

2. DISABLING COOKIES

Each browser has different procedures for managing settings and they may be disabled directly by the browser by rejecting/revoking the consent to use cookies. Hereinafter, you may find the specific instructions for each browser:

3. THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

This site acts as an intermediary for third-party cookies which are used to provide visitors with additional services and functions and to improve the use of the site, like the buttons for social networks.
